CPT states: The Tip of the Catheter and/or Device must terminate in the Subclavian, Brachiocephalic (innominate) or Iliac Veins, or the Superior, Inferior Vena Cava or Right Atrium.

If the Anesthesiologist places the “CVP”, per ASA Relative Value Guide use the following CPT codes:

36555 – patients less than 5 yrs old (Centrally inserted)

36556 – patients 5 yrs of age and older

36568 – PICC, patients less than 5 yrs old (Peripherally inserted)

36569 – PICC, patients 5 yrs of age and older

+76937 (ultrasound) is an add-on code used for the initial placement.

76000 (fluoro) is for the repositioning through the same access site of a CVP (cath or device) already in place, while +77001 is for the placement, replacement (through a different access site) or the removal of a CVP (cath or device) .
